#### 7.1 President

- **7.1.1** Provincially, campaign to get part-time union votes counted will be starting up again
- **7.1.2** Some colleges are seeing the elimination of Partial Load faculty
- **7.1.3** Mediation for six grievances at once, result was gaining three full-time positions. There are concerns over whether the college filling these positions will result in a net increase in the full-time complement, which is the intent of the settlement
- **7.1.4** Grievance over discipline of a faculty member is moving through expedited arbitration
- 7.1.5 Issue with faculty member who was seconded but was recorded as a "leave without pay". Initial meetings over the issue were not productive, and a grievance was filed. Initial meeting with new HR director was more productive and the leave should be properly categorized, although we are still waiting for the Step 2 response. Members who take on special projects or alternative workloads should always consult with the union to ensure that their rights and benefits are not negatively affected
- **7.1.6** Union will attempt to recoup the purchased time for LEC treasurer while he is on sick leave
